From the very beginning, when Victoria first set up her chilly Spitalfields market stall in 2011, she has been passionate about creating beautifully crafted products using only ethical, sustainable, and locally sourced materials. That commitment still guides everything we do today.

Victoria personally visits and selects each supplier, ensuring they meet our high standards for quality, sustainability, and fair working conditions. Many have been with us since the start, their skill and care woven into every small-batch creation. Together, we're keeping British craftsmanship alive; thoughtfully, responsibly, and with heart.

Our fine bone china mugs are handmade in Stoke-on-Trent using clay from Cornwall and passing through the hands of over 10 skilled artisans. Each piece is hand-crafted ensuring exceptional quality and lasting British craftsmanship.

From Victoria's hand-drawn British designs to the **Cornish clay** used in fine bone china, and even the box it arrives in — every detail is thoughtfully made to give you the **perfect Great British cuppa**.

Over 20 pairs of skilled hands can be involved in making each mug, jug, cup, saucer, or espresso cup. Every handle is carefully attached by hand, every glaze applied with precision, and every piece inspected to meet our **exacting standards**. And the best part? Every single step happens right **here in England**.

Duchess China, A Heritage of Craftsmanship

Victoria Eggs mugs are proudly made by **Duchess China**, based in Staffordshire, a ceramics manufacturer **handcrafting fine bone china since 1888**. Duchess is one of the last historic bone china producers remaining in the UK, blending traditional skill with modern sustainability.

Supporting independent British businesses has been a priority for Victoria from day one, and Duchess China was a natural partner. Their **generations of hand-skilled craftsmanship** ensure that every piece carries the **heritage and quality** associated with Staffordshire ceramics.

From Clay to Cup, The Craft Behind Every Piece

- **Fine Bone China:** The clay comes from St. Austell, Cornwall, and is mixed with **bone ash recycled from a local butchery**, giving each mug exceptional strength while reducing landfill waste.
- **Precision Shaping & Assembly:** Each handle is attached by hand, and every mug, jug, cup, saucer, and espresso cup is carefully formed to ensure **perfect balance and durability**.
- **Triple-Stage Glazing:** Every piece is **hand-dipped into glaze**, creating the smooth, glossy finish we associate with fine bone china. Mugs are then fired at a high temperature for strength, and again at a lower temperature to set the glaze.



- **Waste Not:** Any imperfections are either corrected or sent to **local recyclers**, including tile manufacturers, ensuring **minimal waste** at every stage.
- **Energy-Efficient Production:** Duchess China has invested in **energy-saving kilns and processes**, using excess heat to dry clay and reduce energy usage.

Finishing Touches

After firing and glazing, each piece is **individually hand-checked** to ensure it meets Victoria Eggs' exacting standards. Handles are aligned, surfaces polished, and minor imperfections corrected. The result is **beautifully smooth, fault-free mugs, cups, jugs, and espresso cups** that feel as delightful to hold as they do to drink from. Every mug comes boxed with care, reflecting the same attention to detail that went into its creation — ready for gifting or enjoying your daily tea or coffee.

- Safe Cleaning:** Any cleaning processes are **environmentally safe**, avoiding unnecessary chemicals while maintaining quality.

Every item is **individually hand-sewn by skilled UK seamstresses** and hand-packaged using **fully recyclable materials**. We've replaced single-use plastic label ties with eco-friendly jute string, ensuring every detail aligns with our sustainability ethos.

Our textiles manufacturer is **SEDEX-registered and SMETA 4-Pillar accredited**, ensuring excellent working conditions and a safe, ethical workplace throughout production.
