Used daily or weekly, Beeswax Wraps can last beyond 6 months with proper care. They are 100% natural, reusable, compostable, and will keep your food fresh for longer.

Our **Reusable Face Pads** are made with luxury organic bamboo velour (GOT certified) and 100% cotton floral fabric. They are super soft and can be washed in the washing machine.

Our **Zero Waste Sponges** are reusable, compostable, washable kitchen sponges made from 100% cotton, bamboo fabric and hessian to give that extra 'scrubiness'. They will last for a year and can be washed in the washing machine.

Our **Face Masks** are made from three layers of organic cotton, and are reusable and washable.

Frequently Asked Questions

1. What are the advantages of Beeswax Wraps?

100% natural as well as being reusable and compostable. Keep your food fresh for longer.

2. How do Beeswax Wraps work?

Use the warmth of your hands to help mould the Beeswax Wrap over a piece of food or dish. The Beeswax Wrap will hold its seal once it starts to cool down. Your food can still breathe, so the wrap will keep your food fresh. We don't recommend you use them with pineapples, raw meat or fish.

3. What are Beeswax Wraps made of?

100% cotton fabric, natural beeswax, pine resin and jojoba oil (both have anti-bacterial and anti-fungal properties)

4. How long will my Beeswax Wraps last for?

Your Beeswax Wraps can last up to 6 months to a year and beyond with proper care. When your Beeswax Wrap's life comes to an end you can pop it in the compost or use as firelighters.

5. How do I take care of my Beeswax Wrap?

After use, wash your Beeswax Wrap with mild dish washing soap and cool water, and then let it hang to dry. You can store your wrap in a drawer or on the counter. Click on 'how to videos' on the home page. Do not use hot water, as the wax will start to melt.

6. What if my wraps don't stick anymore?

The wraps can be refreshed by ironing in between parchment paper or they can be sent back to us for a re-wax, this is offered free of charge - all you have to do is send us a self-addressed envelope. Go to the 'contact us' page on the website.

7. Can I put my Beeswax Wraps in the microwave?

Our Beeswax Wraps cannot be used in the microwave.

8. Who makes your Beeswax Wraps?

We make all our own wraps in the UK, this way we can be sure that the fabric and wax work perfectly together to give you the best results.

9. Any allergy concerns I need to be aware of?

Yes, our wraps contain Pine Resin which could cause an allergic reaction.

10. Any other safety issues I need to know about?

Beeswax is highly flammable, so please be careful near naked flames.
